Tuesday (and Wednesday?)	Discovery of the withered fig tree (11:20–25) Controversies with religious leaders (11:27–12:44) Olivet Discourse (13:1–37)
Thursday	Anointing at Bethany, betrayal by Judas (14:1–11) Passover and Last Supper (14:12–31) Gethsemane (14:32–42) Arrest and Jewish trial (14:43–72)
Friday	Roman trial (15:1–15) Crucifixion (15:16–32) Burial (15:42–47)
Saturday	In the grave
Sunday	Resurrection (16:1–8)
