The problem of a Gap

The result: We cannot understand the thoughts of God.

The Bible describes two kinds of wisdom:

Summary: The Holy Spirit knows the depths of God and illuminates us

- teaches us, guides us into all the truth (The truth of God)
- reminds us of things that God has said (The Bible)
- glorifies Jesus (makes Him known, magnifies Him)
- gives understanding and clarity to Scripture, reveals the deep wisdom of God
- gives us the "mind of Christ"

QUESTION: WHAT DOES THIS MEAN IN OUR LIVES?

FIRST: Since eternal life is knowing God, the Holy Spirit makes this possible by illuminating the Word of God.

APPENDIX: A PROMISE FROM JESUS

JOHN 14:21: Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them."

- 1) Study God's Word every day. Have a plan, take it into your heart.
- 2) Trust the Holy Spirit to teach you, to help you know the mind of God.
- 3) Ask God to help you see what He wants you to see. Own it.
- 4) Plan to obey and follow Jesus.
- 5) Share something. Encourage someone; delight in making Jesus known.

A start at memorizing and meditating on Scripture.

Three tips: (1) Read it out loud repeatedly (e.g. 50X) over a number of days. (2) Have a simple way to practice after you have read it out loud. For example, you can use 3x5 cards, use an app (e.g. AnkiMobile flashcards phone app (has a blue star), or read it into a recorder and listen to it, (3) share the verses with people, letting them know what God is teaching you.
