**Healings-** The gift of healings is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body to serve as human intermediaries through whom it pleases God to cure illness and restore health apart from human means. It usually validates God's messenger and message and focuses people on the glory of God and his mighty works.

1 Cor. 12:9, 28; Acts 3:1-10; 5:12-16; 9:32-35; 28:7-10

**Miracles-** The gift of miracles is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body to serve as human intermediaries through whom it pleases God to perform powerful acts that are perceived by observers to have altered the ordinary course of nature. It usually validates God's messenger and message and focuses people on the glory of God and his mighty works.

1 Cor 12:10, 28; Acts 9:36-42; 19:11-20; 20:7-12; Romans 15:18-19; 2 Cor. 12:12

**Discerning of Spirits-** The discerning of Spirits is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body to distinguish between truth and error, between God's Spirit and other spirits, and good and evil, focusing people on the glory of God and his mighty works.

1 Cor 12:10, Acts 5:1-11; 16:16-18; 1 John 4:1-6; Matt 16:21-23

**Tongues-**The gift of tongues is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body to speak with languages that are unknown to them without having any previous knowledge of that language. It results in corporate edification when interpreted, in personal repentance of lost souls, and usually validates God's messenger and message, focusing people on the glory of God and his mighty works.

1 Cor 12-14; Acts 2:3-4, 11; 8:14-18; 10:46; 19:6

Interpretation of Tongues The gift of interpretation of tongues is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body to make known in the vernacular the message of one who speaks in tongues. It results in the edification of the corporate body with revelation, knowledge, prophecy or teaching and usually validates God's messenger and message, focusing people on the glory of God and his mighty works.
