

# 2S/3S AT HOME - MARCH



Hey families! Here's a look at what your kids are learning this month.

## MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE

"Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

## MARCH 2ND

This week, your kids hear Jesus tell a story about **the lost sheep**.

- **BIBLE:** Luke 15:1-7
- **BIBLE TRUTH:** Jesus teaches us!
- **CHALLENGE:** Play hide and seek with your kids using their stuffed animals! Celebrate loudly and big when they find what you hide.

## MARCH 9TH

This week, your kids hear Jesus share a story about **the lost coin**.

- **BIBLE:** Matthew 25:14-29
- **BIBLE TRUTH:** Jesus teaches us!
- **CHALLENGE:** Play hide and seek with your kids using nickels, quarters, dimes, or pennies! Celebrate loudly and big when they find what you hide.

## MARCH 16TH

This week, your kids hear Jesus tell a story about a **Samaritan** who **helps a wounded man** when no one else did.

- **BIBLE:** Luke 10:25–37
- **BIBLE TRUTH:** Jesus teaches us!
- **CHALLENGE:** Dramatic play with your kid different occupations that help people – consider doctor, firefighter, police officer, sanitation worker, store clerk, teacher. Talk about how there are so many ways we can help others – by saving, rescuing, teaching, healing, encouraging, serving!

## **MARCH 23RD**

This week, your kids hear Jesus share a story about what happens **when a house is built on rock versus sand**.

- **BIBLE:** Luke 6:47-49, Matthew 7:24-27
- **BIBLE TRUTH:** Jesus teaches us!
- **CHALLENGE:** Building a tower with what you have and knock it down together. Consider building the tower on the ground and then on a less firm surface (like the couch, a blanket, or pillow!)

## **MARCH 30TH**

This week, your kids hear Jesus tell a story about **a father's love for his lost son**.

- **BIBLE:** Luke 15:11-32
- **BIBLE TRUTH:** Jesus teaches us!
- **CHALLENGE:** Show photos to your kids of people in your family. Talk about who they are in your family, why you love them so much, your favorite thing about them, and your favorite thing to do with them.
