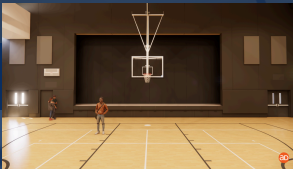

When we launched For the One, I just knew it would be one of the most meaningful journeys we've ever taken together as a church. Why? Because this initiative has never really been about a building. It's about people. It's about the one person who hasn't yet found Jesus, hasn't found their community, their hope. And whenever God calls us to make room for others, He has a way of changing us in the process. I have to be honest with you—I was excited when we started this, but what you have done in just the first month has left me genuinely amazed. In the very first month of this two-year journey we saw the first \$1 million given toward For the One goal of \$7.5 million! That's amazing! That is the faithfulness of God multiplied through the faithfulness of His people!



Here's where things stand right now: we are working closely with our architects in what is called the Design and Development Phase—the final stage of design work before formal construction documents are produced. It is exciting to watch this vision move from something we've prayed about to something we can actually see taking shape on paper. We are on track, and we are believing God for a mid-summer groundbreaking. I hope you'll mark your calendar and plan to be there—it is going to be a moment worth celebrating together.

Over the next two years, I'll keep sending updates like this one so you stay connected to what God is doing in us and through us. We are only in the first chapter of this story, and I am already so inspired by what I'm seeing. Thank you for trusting God with me. Let's keep going—for the one.
