

Job Description:**Hunger Action Advocate/Church and Community Service Catalyst**

- Part time: 5 hours per week
- Supervisor: Executive Presbyter

Educator, Motivator, Connector and Facilitator for the Presbyterian Hunger Program (PHP) within North Central California Presbytery. Support Churches by visitations to food programs, ministries and events. Build relationships with church leaders, members, volunteers, community partnerships, and organizations. Actively engage with local organizations that address hunger and food insecurity. Work with churches wishing to advocate for policy changes, raise awareness and educate others about the root causes of hunger.

Duties:

Support NCCP congregations engaged in ministries related to Hunger and Food insecurity. Facilitate and encourage cooperation and collaboration. Introduce and expand partnerships and service opportunities for Churches to connect and serve together in their communities. Connect church leaders with community organizations, other churches and organizations to develop partnerships.

Publicize opportunities for service and advocacy around hunger and food insecurity issues through Presbytery newsletter, visits to churches, and presentations at Presbytery gatherings.

Connect NCCP congregations to PCUSA organizations and resources such as the Presbyterian Hunger Program and Matthew 25 Initiative. Promote One Great Hour of Sharing in local churches.

Attend NCCP Presbytery meetings and coordinate Centsibility Offerings

Provide quick solutions to inquiries for assistance. Conduct prompt communications.

Leadership development to empower leaders within Churches to outreach and serve.
