 - Finance Committee Update

Total Assets = Total Liabilities + Fund Balances + Temporary Restricted \$16,643,897.14 = (\$75,286.25) + \$12,071,183.60 + \$4,647,999.79Church audit for the 2024 has begun. The report will be completed in July 2025.

Work has begun on developing a three-year budget for 2026-28. The Finance committee is meeting with Metropolis representatives for a better understanding of the reporting and forecasting.

VI. Jr. Warden's Report – *Rick Patrick*

- Facilities Report
 - i. No progress on the window repair in Bethell Hall. We are 3rd in line for a street permit for repair. The window is not in danger.
 - ii. Waiting on handrails in Historic Church to go under the floor to create support.
 - iii. Lighting was reviewed for garage and the pulpit
 - iv. Drip lines have been installed on the west side of the garage and by entrance of the garage.
 - v. Vending machine has been installed in Holy Grounds, bottle water for unhoused neighbors
 - vi. New flooring for Vestry and Acolyte's room Vestry meeting in July will be in Crail C.
 - vii. One of the elevators in the garage failed inspection and is out of order till fixed

VII. Church Update -- Mother Hope and Jim Lamm

- No changes in staff
- April attendance numbers are up and running 10-15% ahead from last years. Visitors have continued to be steady.
- Upcoming events for Ascension for families and feasts
- Spirit Night on Amy's and Phil's on Burnet for Youth fundraiser (Tuesday, June 3rd 4-8pm)
- Vacation Bible School will start next week.
- Day School is doing well for registration for the Fall and opening an infant room.

 - i. From the profits from Next-to-New there were 8 grants to give away this year. It is recommended to award the grants as soon as possible instead of waiting until the Fall as that has been done in the past.

- Update on Garage & Hospitality Marketing Taskforce *Jim Lamm*
 - i. Committee is creating market plans for the church, working on marketing for The Space, Alexis and Jim are working to network for conference and meeting space in the absence of the Convention Center.
 - ii. The parking garage information was shared. Revenue is up but weekend parking continues to be lower than in years past. Contract parkers, such as Omni business offices, are reducing the number of their contracts.
 - iii. Hospitality is looking at opening for every Thursday serving lunch instead of two Thursdays a month
 - iv. Possibly create short updates for parish and committees to learn about work from the Taskforce

 - i. Rector Search: Profile Committee Melanie Moore
 - 1. Structure will be 4 people with mentors for committee members to seek counsel and advice from.
 - 2. Timeline was drafted for the work.
 - 3. Survey company needs to be used to gather information to involve the parish possible company to use is Holy Cow! Consulting, possibly done in July discussion to push survey back to August to wait for parishioners to be back from summer vacations.
 - 4. Information sessions to be shared with parish end of summer and have profile turn around by September or October.

 - 1. Vestry members will need to attend transition training possible dates were discussed and will be proposed to Cannon Johnson.
