



Calvary Celebration of Life Services - Frequently Asked Questions

Who can have a funeral at Calvary, and how do I schedule a service?

Calvary funerals are an option for Calvary members and their families.

When and where are funeral services held?

Our staff will provide help and support for all those experiencing loss - however, the ability to hold a service at Calvary depends on the availability of the church's facilities and staff.

- Services can typically be held **in the morning, Monday through Saturday.**
- Available worship spaces:
 - Golden Valley Worship Center - seats 750
 - Golden Valley Chapel - seats 150
 - Minnetonka Worship Center - seats 175

What fees are involved?

Required:

- Presiding pastor Honorarium - \$300
- Production Team Member (*based on venue space chosen*)
 - Golden Valley Worship Center - \$300
 - Golden Valley Chapel - \$200
 - Minnetonka Worship Center - \$200
- Calvary On-Site Host - \$100

With option to have service Live Streamed: viewed at events.calvary.org

- Chapel: \$250
- Worship Center: \$750 (*\$375 per technician*)

Other fees:

- Musician fees - set by and payable directly to musicians - \$250-300
- Reception food and serving fees - set by and payable to caterer

Does Calvary provide food for a reception?

No. Please keep in mind that you are responsible for ordering any food/beverages and arranging for serving and clean-up either by catering staff or friends/family. Suggestions for caterers and servers who are familiar with working in our space are available upon request.

Does Calvary print bulletins for services?

No, Calvary does not print bulletins. You are welcome to print your own or have them printed and bring them with you the day of the service.

What is the next step?

Once a date has been set, Calvary staff will help you plan the service. You will meet with the presiding pastor and/or funeral coordinator who will help you make decisions regarding music preferences, scripture readings, eulogists, etc.
