Refresh

Read Ephesians 3:14-20 to get the Scripture passage back in your mind.

Discuss

What specifically have you found encouraging in Paul's prayer here at the end of Ephesians 3, and why has this been encouraging?

What does this passage teach us about the resources of God? What affect should this have on us?

What can Paul's prayer here in Ephesians teach us about how we pray? Specifically about our expectations related to prayer.

Why do you think Paul "built" his prayer the way he did?

He's able to do
He's able to do what you ask
He's able to do what you ask or think
He's able to do all you ask or think
He's able to do more than you ask or think
He's able to do far more than you ask or think
He's able to do far more abundantly than you ask or think

Why would Paul say that praying this way brings glory to <u>the church</u> and <u>to Christ</u>? Why is the church emphasized over the individual?

How would memorizing verses 20-21 be helpful?
