

Sermon Discussion Guide February 25, 2024

Refresh

Read Romans 9:1-5, 10:1-4, 11:1-5, 11:11-16, and 11:25-32 to get the Scripture passage back in your mind.

Discuss

How does Romans 9:1-5 describe the unique privileges of the Jewish people? Where do we see these privileges more thoroughly explained in the Old Testament?

What about Israel's history makes it astonishing that God would continually be faithful to them? What does this tell us about God? How might this encourage us as believers today?

How does Paul show his love for his people in Romans 9-11? How is this particularly poignant in Romans 9:3? What does this tell us about Paul and his love for the gospel?

Why are we so often unconcerned or apathetic about the spiritual condition of those around us? What does this apathy say about how we think of people, as well as how we think about the gospel?

What are some ways that believers can grow in their urgency for others to know the gospel? What has served to heighten your urgency for evangelism?

In what ways does the church function as a display of God's glory to the world around us? What tends to help us radiate the glory of Christ more faithfully? What tends to keep us from radiating God's glory well?
