Refresh

Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-32 to get the Scripture passage back in your mind.

Discuss

In what ways does this passage indicate that this is to be a corporate meal, not merely an individual one we do at home? Why would this be important for us to understand?

Why does Paul take the church of Corinth back to the night of Jesus' betrayal? How does that event inform our understanding of the Lord's supper?

How does verse 24 highlight the personal nature of Christ's sacrifice on our behalf? Why should this be an incredible encouragement to us as believers?

Considering verses 23-26, what are some of the reasons we observe the Lord's supper? Why might these reasons be important for us as believers?

How does this passage speak to the frequency with which we should partake of this meal?

What steps could we take to prepare for this meal before we come to church? How might we help prepare our families to come around the table?
