

Sermon Discussion Guide November 3, 2024

Refresh

Read Matthew 26:57-64, Luke 23:7-11, and John 19:1-9 to get the Scripture passages back in your mind.

Discuss

Take some time to reflect on the circumstances surrounding Jesus' arrest and trial. What were some of the injustices he experienced during this time? Why do you think Jesus would stay silent during the times He did not speak?

Take a moment to read Isaiah 52:14 together. What does this verse tell us about the love and grace of Jesus? What does this verse communicate about the nature of our sin?

What did Jesus' silence communicate regarding His relationship with the Father? How is His relationship with the Father described throughout the gospels?

What does Jesus' silence before His accusers do for us today? In what ways does His silence enable us to not be silent before our accuser? How does Revelation 12:10-12 describe the hope we have as a result of Jesus' work?

Take some time to read through Isaiah 53 as a group and reflect on Isaiah's prophecy of Jesus' sacrificial work on our behalf. After discussing His work, spend a few minutes giving Him thanks for His work in our place.
