IT'S ALL GOOD

A SERMON SERIES | JANUARY 18 - FEBRUARY 15

At the heart of Scripture is a simple, surprising claim: before the Bible names what is broken, it declares what is good. Again and again, the Bible returns to that word - good - not as a slogan, but as a way of seeing the world and our place in it.

In this five-week series, we trace how Scripture teaches us to recognize goodness as it unfolds over time. In Genesis, goodness is spoken over creation as a gift. In Israel's story, goodness is found when people return to the good way they had forgotten. In the Psalms, goodness is discovered in life shared together. In the Gospel, goodness takes flesh in Jesus, the Good Shepherd. And in Paul's letters, goodness becomes something we are invited to hold fast to in our everyday lives.

As a new year begins, *It's All Good* invites us to look for the good in the world - not by ignoring what is broken, but by learning again how God names, restores, and reveals what is truly good.
