

Frequently Asked Questions

What Happens at a Worship Service?

We have two services at 9:15am and 11:00am and you will see a mix of elements during our worship services. Typically, you can expect announcements, worship through singing, and a top-notch message from our senior pastor. What Should I Wear?

As an intercultural, intergenerational church you will see a variety of attire on our campus. From jeans and dresses to suits and shorts—you will likely experience it all. We want you to feel and be comfortable, so we invite you to come as you are!

Will You Ask Me For Money?

During our services, we do invite our members and regular people to give as they feel led. We do not pass a bucket around during service, as most people choose to give online. As one of our guests, we just want you to be here with us, so there is no expectation from us for you to give.

Where Do I Go?

We have a few entrances to our building, so we know it can be confusing! Please enter through our Main Worship Doors located on the playground side of the building. Hint: the main entrance is near our Guest Parking!

If you're a first-time guest or returning guest, please make sure to swing by Connection Point to receive a small gift! You are our honored guest and we're so glad you're here!

Where Do I Park?

Please look for our Guest Parking signs, so you know where to park! Near that area, you will see our main entrance to the lobby and Worship Center. Once inside, you will see our Café on the left and Connection Point on the right. Make sure to grab a fresh cup of coffee and enter through.

Where is the Bathroom?

We have bathrooms located in the hallways around the Worship Center. If you're entering through our main lobby, the closest bathrooms are near our café (take a left down the hallway, and a bathroom is located on the right corner). If you enter through one of rear entrances, there is a bathroom located by Entrance 15.

We would love to get you connected to what God is doing at Fellowship. The best way to learn more about who we are is to submit a Connect Card and someone from our Guest Services Team will follow up with you. You can also stop by Connection Point and talk to one of our Connection Point Hosts. We
