Pastor's Note by Stina Koppes

Early in the morning of the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been taken away from the tomb.

~ John 20:1



This month we have the gift of celebrating Holy Week together. Beginning with Palm Sunday and culminating in Easter, we retell the story from triumphant procession to triumphant resurrection and everything in between. For many of us, the story is familiar. We think we know it and so we may wonder why it matters to show up to hear the story again.

Holy Week is not a story.

We do not gather to put on a pageant and retell historical events from years gone by simply to remember the past.

Holy Week causes us to be re-membered.

God enters into all parts of our story. The exciting parades and triumphant arrivals. The gatherings around tables during holiday meals. The anguish of isolation late at night. The reality of betrayal, denial, abandonment, derision, suffering, and even death. God enters into our story and shows us that the worst thing is never the last thing. Resurrection is on the way and we are put back together – re-membered – as new creations.

Jesus offers us this gift every Holy Week.

I invite you to enter into the passion of the story. Participate in each element. Allow the times of worship to act as a means of grace in your life. God is waiting for you at the cross. Will you sit with him, or will you pass by pretending you see nothing?

In order for God to roll the stones away from your life, you must let him take this journey with you. Don't do it alone. Join me for worship on Palm Sunday (April 13 at 10am), Maundy Thursday worship (April 17 at 5:30pm), Good Friday (12pm or 6:30pm) and Easter Sunday (8am or 10am). May the joy of journeying from the cross to resurrected life be yours this April.



April 6 - The Beloved John 15:1-17

As we approach the events of Holy Week, we meet the beloved disciple, John. Writer of a gospel and many New Testament letters, this close companion of Jesus is believed to have heard the very heartbeat of God and invites us to do the same. Today we also welcome, Chad Lanners, Executive Director of CROSS Services to speak during worship about how we too can love our local neighbors through our work with CROSS Services.

April 17 - Maundy Thursday

John 13:1-35

Join us for dinner and communion at the tables as we gather for a remembrance of Jesus' last supper with his disciples. This worship service will not be recorded and is available in-person only. Including dramatic monologues of Jesus' disciples and music by the choir.

April 20 - Easter - I've Seen the Lord

John 20:1-18

Celebrate Easter at Cross Winds. We have two worship services that are family friendly and ready to bring joy to your Easter. We've saved a seat for you. Worship at 8am or 10am



April 13 - Palm Sunday Luke 19:28-48

alm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, which centers around a triumphant procession where Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey while crowds cheer "Hosanna," or "Save us." Join us for Palm Sunday worship as we welcome Jesus, looking to him as our Hosanna, and consider what his saving work means for us today. After worship, we invite you to stay for a potluck. Bring your favorite brunch food to share.

April 18- Good Friday Tenebrae Services

John 18:1-19:42

Gather at the foot of the cross for a traditional Good Friday Tenebrae Service. A Service of Tenebrae, or "Shadows," is an extended meditation on the passion of Christ, featuring readings from the Gospel of John and the extinguishing of candles. Services will be offered at 12pm and 6:30pm.

April 27 - Life In His Name

John 20:19-31

The Gospel of John declares, "But these things are written so that you will believe that Jesus is the Christ, God's Son, and that believing, you will have life in his name." (John 20:31) Today we celebrate the life that comes through believing in the powerful name of Jesus.


REGISTRATION OPEN for Summer Festival Camp High School Camp: July 13-16, 2025 Middle School Camp: July 20-23, 2025
