GENERAL SUMMARY

The purpose of the Lakeview Youth Intern is to provide leadership and development to middle school ministry specifically and while assisting with youth ministry generally at Lakeview Covenant. This position is developmental in nature with a narrow focus of responsibility and high degree of innovation encouraged within the ministry focus. The Lakeview Youth Intern will gain practical leadership experience and develop a theological framework for biblical and healthy ministry.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

Provide a reliable, consistent, and hospitable ministry space on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings for middle school youth who attend Lakeview Covenant Church.

Provide plans, delegate responsibilities, and lead the discipleship time for middle schoolers on Sunday mornings.

Proactively seek to develop mentoring and discipleship relationships with Lakeview Youth outside of Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.

Maintain a consistent pattern of attendance at and/or engagement with youth activities not related to the ministries of Lakeview Covenant Church.

Assist Pastor of Next Gen Ministries with planning, preparation, and leadership of youth ministry as needed.

Recruit leaders and provide leadership for Middle School Youth events, retreats, and trips.
