The Youth Ministry Pastor (YMP), under the direction of the NextGen Pastor, is a key position that leads the development and management of youth ministry environments and volunteer teams, creating spaces that facilitate encounters with Jesus and promote spiritual growth within teenagers. The YMP will lead efforts to equip adult team members with a clear vision and purpose, empowering them to effectively support Lakeview Covenant's mission. The YMP will prioritize intergenerational relationships as a core discipleship strategy while providing a robust missional strategy for reaching young people and mobilizing their faith in their contexts.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Strengthen and deepen Lakeview Covenant's commitment to reaching, forming, and commissioning teenagers with a deeply formed life and a life-long faith in Jesus
- Deepen and expand annual strategies of discipleship for Sunday morning and mid-week gatherings
- Develop leadership pathways for small groups of teenagers
- Provide off-site discipleship and outreach experiences through intentional and creative camp, retreat, and cross-cultural service events or trips.
- Build and equip teams of adults who serve as disciple makers for teenagers
- Establish and maintain trusting partnerships with youth families and the elder generations of congregants at Lakeview Covenant.
- Strategically and faithfully work to expand the reach of youth ministry throughout the surrounding communities and neighborhoods in Duluth.
- Commit to continual learning within the intersections of theology and youth culture, influence, and need.
- Collaborate with Lakeview staff, ministry leaders, and local mission partners for the sake of providing robust discipleship and mission development within youth ministry
