It was a great privilege for me to attend this annual meeting as a guest of the Louisville Conference and to have accompany me, Mrs. Gibson Whittaker, representing the local women of the Louisville East District. As the theme was developed we became increasingly aware of the great change taking place here and now. Just as a quarter of a century ago the "Woman's Society of Christian Service" came into being, we are today witnessing the birth of a new church, The United Methodist Church, and a new "Women's Society of Christian Service".

We have tried some new ideas this year, both in leadership training, and in worship. Your reaction has been very gratifying to those who worked hard to prepare these programs for you. Also you have shown wonderful response to requests from the District whether it was extra money for supply work; for the Wesley Foundation at the University of Louisville; volunteers for tutoring; for Wesley House or for the projects of Church Women United. Thank you for your support.

As the year draws to a close we are very happy to welcome into the Louisville East District four Societies from the Central Jurisdiction. They are: Calvary, New Coke, Hobbs Chapel and St. Paul (Jeffersontown). This brings our total number of Societies to 39 with 1 District Member.
