INTRODUCTION

It's a book of books—sixty-six of them, in fact. This book of books is divided into two sections—the Old Testament and the New Testament. It includes many different genres of writing, including history, sermons, letters, songs, poems, architectural plans, family trees, and various other forms. It was written by over 40 human authors from every background (kings, peasants, philosophers, fishermen, poets, scholars, etc.). It's not the product of any one generation, guru, people, ethnicity, or culture. In short, the Christian Scriptures are multiethnic, multicultural, and global.

The Bible is one, unified story that centers on the person and work of Jesus Christ. As the word of God about himself, it's filled with power, life, light, wisdom, and the way of salvation. Therefore, if we want to know God, we must take the Bible seriously and learn to understand it diligently
