# HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

To maintain a healthy group, focus on four key components: Word, prayer, relationships, and outreach. This guide will help you study a biblical passage through observation, interpretation, and application. As you explore Matthew 28:18-20, keep in mind this week's big idea: **in this house, we are disciples of Jesus who make disciples of Jesus.**





# CONNECT

- Ask this ice-breaker: "Share about a time when someone invested in you—maybe a mentor, teacher, or friend—and helped you grow in some area of life. What impact did that have on you?"





# INTRODUCTION

Matthew 28:18-20, known as the Great Commission, captures Jesus' final instructions to His disciples after His resurrection. This passage forms the foundation for the church's mission, emphasizing that discipleship—repenting, believing, following Jesus, and helping others do the same—is central to the church's identity. As you study, ask God to speak to you about your next steps in growth as a disciple of Jesus who makes disciples of Jesus.





# OBSERVATIONS & INTERPRETATION

*Read: Matthew 28:18-20*

- How does His resurrection authority empower us to fulfill the command to make disciples?
- What does this command say about the active, outward focus of Christianity, beyond just personal faith?





# OBSERVATIONS & INTERPRETATION

*Read: Matthew 28:19*

- What does baptism signify in the process of becoming a disciple?
- The mission extends to "all nations" (v. 19). How does this global vision challenge us to think beyond our local community or comfort zones?





# OBSERVATIONS & INTERPRETATION

*Read: Matthew 28:20*

- How does discipleship extend beyond the moment of conversion and baptism?
- How does the promise of Jesus' presence encourage us when making disciples feels daunting?
