

Trunk or Treat Guidelines

If you plan to participate with your vehicle at the Trunk or Treat, please read!

Participating vehicles will need to be parked in the designated area no later than 3:30 pm (you can come as early as 3pm). All cars have an assigned parking spot, and the parking lot team can help direct you to your spot in the west (main) parking lot.

Open up and decorate your trunk or the back of your vehicle. There are some great trunk decorating ideas on the internet!! Please refrain from anything overly spooky or gory. Possibilities could include a Halloween theme, sports, comic characters, Biblical, exotic locations, a particular decade, and can be as elaborate or simple as you wish. If lights are needed, please ensure they're battery-powered, as electricity will not be available on-site. From 4-5 pm, please refrain from playing music or sounds at your trunk, as this hour is a sensory-friendly time for children who prefer less overwhelming sounds.

If you plan to wear a costume, please refrain from wearing a mask. For security purposes, we want to make sure that all adults are identifiable.

Bring some lawn chairs to sit in and hand out candy to the kids! Compliment costumes! Meet a family! Have fun!

For candy, please only bring store-bought individually wrapped treats. Or consider giving out a non-candy treat (bubbles, other small prizes). Every year is different, but we typically expect around 400 children to attend the event. We will have surplus candy to share if cars run out, but supplies are still limited.

For safety reasons, please plan to stay parked and decorated until 6pm, breaking down your decorations and leaving after that.
