Shadowing (Visiting) Children Program

The Daycare at Dayspring Christian Academy (DCA) Shadowing Program provides a unique opportunity for potential children to experience a typical day at our Daycare. Your child will have the opportunity to observe the classroom, get to know teachers, meet other children, and experience Daycare life.

Shadow Day Information:

- Arrive at the school office by 9:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled appointment.
- Shadow day hours are 9am to 11am.
- Visiting children must be conservatively dressed similar to the DCA guidelines. Conservative dress means a visiting child cannot wear anything inappropriate.
For specific questions, please call the Daycare Director or refer to the dress code which can be found in the Parent-Student Handbook under the Daycare tab on the school website, <https://dayspring-academy.org/daycare/>.
- Parent must pack a change of clothing, diapers, wipes, a snack, a bottle of water and/or milk, and pacifier, and a comfort accessory (like a toy, doll, stuffed animal) from home for that day.
- Shadowing children must behave appropriately (follow directions, be respectful, be attentive, etc.).
- Shadowing children are not permitted to bring any electronic devices to school, including cell phones, ipods, gaming devices, etc.
- Complete the Visiting Student Emergency Form and bring it prior to the morning of the shadow day.
- Sign your child/ren in and out of the school office on the day of shadowing.
