PURPOSE

Mt. Olive has the potential of attracting children and young families from across our areas of Suwannee and Columbia Counties. However, do to the current safety, accessibility and usability issues. It is hindering any significant growth of young families. This has brought Mt. Olive Baptist Church to our next phase of expansion... a dedicated children's wing on the east side of our current sanctuary building.

This next phase of expansion—a dedicated children's wing on the east side of our sanctuary—will provide a safe, welcoming, and Christ-centered space where young lives can be shaped for eternity. Through this ministry, Mt. Olive seeks not only to strengthen existing families but also to open the doors wide for new families from Wellborn and beyond to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ.

This New Children's Building Will Feature:

- Accessible parking and direct connection to the sanctuary
- A dedicated entrance with covered drop-off for safety and convenience
- A vibrant, secure environment designed with families in mind

Lobby & Check-In

The lobby and check-in area will be warm, colorful, and spacious, helping families feel at home the moment they arrive. A central information center will guide parents and children to the right classes and activities. More than just a check-in point, it will be the first step in connecting children to a joyful, Christ-centered place where they can grow as disciples.

Worship Area

The new worship area will be a safe, colorful environment that doubles as an indoor play space when needed. Here, children will sing worship songs, enjoy group activities, experience puppet shows and plays, and host performances for parents. It will also provide access to technology and resources, equipping kids for learning and growth in a Christcentered setting.

Classrooms

Several new classrooms will offer functional, fun, and safe education spaces where children can learn God's Word, build friendships, and be discipled in an environment designed just for them.









WHAT'S MY ROLE?

Are you enthusiastic about giving to this vision but not sure where to start? Here are some creative ways to help allocate or free up resources so you can be a part of "For God's Glory For All Generations."

Decrease: Are there things in your life you can take advantage of less frequently? Maybe it's cutting out Netflix or getting rid of a different streaming service. By decreasing a monthly expense, regardless of what it might be, you can save a significant amount to contribute.

Do More: Often, there are creative ways to save money. Maybe it's been a while since you got a quote for an existing service (i.e., cell phone and cable service). Perhaps you could do some extra comparison or bargain shopping to save funds. For your kids, it could be as easy as saving extra change to give.

Delay: Are there plans you might be making that involve a financial commitment? If so, prayerfully ask God about delaying those plans and using the extra income to contribute.

Donate: A great way to contribute is to give existing assets. Consider giving your appreciated assets (stocks, bonds, real estate) to the church. Letting us sell your assets eliminates potential capital gains taxes and may increase after-tax proceeds. Other items such as automobiles, antiques, jewelry and sports memorabilia could be sold and cash is given to the church.

CAMPAIGN GOALS

Years ago, the building that now houses our children was originally a church sanctuary. Our forefathers could not have foreseen how greatly God would bless the witness and work of Mt. Olive Baptist Church in Wellborn. Over time, we have renovated, expanded, and adapted to meet growing needs. Today, once again, the Lord is calling us to step forward in faith and provide for "For God's Glory For All Generations!"

We believe God will accomplish this through the "For God's Glory For All Generations" campaign. We have three potential goals in this campaign. The first goal is set at an attainable \$600,000. The second goal may take a little faith, set at \$800,000. Our top goal of \$1 million over the next three years, is attainable as well when we give generously with our finished goal in mind. As we seek His provision, let us be encouraged by the testimony of those who have gone before us: 'What God asks us to do, He will certainly enable us to do!'
