# **Transfiguration Sunday**

**Transfiguration Sunday** is a liminal moment. Technically the final Sunday in Epiphany, it is the demarcation of sorts between Epiphany and Lent. The transfiguration, that strange story of Jesus on the mountain with Peter, James, and John when his clothes glowed bright white, is the ultimate epiphany or revelation as we see Jesus in all his glory. It is also a sneak peek of the end (read: goal) of the story.

Some have called the transfiguration a misplaced resurrection story. I think that is half right. It is indeed a glimpse of the resurrection, but there is nothing misplaced about it- at least not in the accidental sense. As we've been talking about resurrection, we have made the point that resurrection is both a moment in time and a way to live and love in this (and every other) moment.

In this way, the transfiguration is a way to show that resurrection is **always** before us; it is **always** in this moment. If we have eyes to see, we can discover the beautiful miracle of resurrection right in front of us. There is never anything misplaced about the resurrection! Indeed, for the people of God, resurrection is our hope today, tomorrow, and on Easter Sunday!
