Welcome to Lent

The season of Lent began yesterday on Ash Wednesday. Here are some of the words I shared...

"The season of Lent begins today. We are given the next 40 days to contemplate the ways that our world is not what it should be. To consider the ways we are not as we could be. The focus on sin and brokenness during Lent is not to generate feelings of guilt. It is not to poke open wounds. To focus on sin and brokenness during Lent is simply to speak honestly and truthfully about what we already know: that things are not as they should be, not as God intended them to be."

Beginning this Sunday, you will notice a few changes in our worship. We are leaving out the **Introit** and the **Passing of the Peace**. Our **Confession of Sin** will be more robust, and our **tone** will turn somber. For the next six weeks we will refrain from 'alleluias' but instead create room for inward reflection and introspection.

Lent will begin in the wilderness with Jesus as we consider Luke 4:1-13. My sermon is entitled, "A Long Obedience in the Same Direction."

Our Lenten devotionals will begin next Wednesday (March 12) at 6:00 PM. We will read and discuss the book *Hope is Here!* by Luther Smith. We will meet in the Art and Soul room. We will offer a virtual option through Microsoft Teams. Contact me if you are interested in the virtual option. More copies of the book will be available this Sunday. The cost is \$10.

Church in Conference

At its called Church in Conference session on Sunday, March 2, 2025, the congregation voted unanimously to allow Kiddos to expand its operation into NDBC's existing 1955-era Fellowship Hall. At the same time, the church voted unanimously to permit our existing Chapel to have its pews removed in favor of upholstered chairs which can be configured for worship services or banquets or receptions.

The costs for converting the existing Fellowship Hall into Kiddos classrooms will be borne by Kiddos.

The costs for new chairs in the chapel, new flooring, and a food prep space behind the chapel will be borne primarily if not exclusively by funds from the Wade Davis Estate and the residual in the NDBC Preschool account. Neither church members nor Trustee accounts nor the NDBC Operating Reserve will be called upon to fund these Chapel enhancements.

NDBC will continue to have exclusive use of the Fellowship Hall (and the kitchen) until work in the Chapel is 100% complete...perhaps late summer or early Fall of 2025. Even after we turn the Fellowship Hall over to Kiddos, NDBC will retain first rights to the existing kitchen.

Going forward we expect the Chapel to become a far more versatile and far more used space, but its use will generally be limited to NDBC members and affiliated programs. Under no circumstances will the Chapel ever be marketed for commercial use.

In the months to come, we will look to donate our 24 pews to another church. However, all members will be welcome to take one or more of these pews—each pew is comprised of two 8 foot segments —into their own homes. The placards which honor NDBC members will be preserved and displayed in the Chapel.

These alterations have been voted on and approved in the hope and the expectation that one of the key missions of our church can be redoubled by opening our doors to more families in need of quality childcare and, further, that our members can come to enjoy more Christian fellowship opportunities in a revitalized and enhanced Chapel.






Phoenix Flies at NDBC Sunday | March 23 | 12:15 PM


