Wednesday Discussions

During the season of Lent, this past spring, we began a series of Wednesday night discussions. Those of us gathered had a wonderful time learning and sharing together. We will pick up Wednesday evening programming beginning in September. With the exception of the first Wednesday of the month (Holy Happy Hour), we will meet from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM in the Art and Soul room. We will finish by 7:00 PM to allow choir members to make it to the choir room. An online option will continue to be offered.

Wednesday Discussions (beginning in September):

- The first Wednesday of each month will continue to be Holy Happy Hour at Round Trip Brewing. We gather from 5:00 to 7:00 PM.
- The second Wednesday of each month we will gather at church at 6:00 PM to discuss a book. We will begin by discussing *The Exvangelicals* by Sarah

McCammon in preparation for her time with us in November. The remainder of the fall we will read, *You are What You Love* by James K. A. Smith. Dr. Smith is a professor at Calvin College. This book discusses relationships among worship, liturgy and spiritual formation.

- The third Wednesday of each month we will gather at the church at 6:00 PM for a pop-up theological discussion. Each month Scott will pick an article from one of the great church publications (Christian Century, Sojourners, etc.). These will be shared on the prior Sunday, and hard copies will be available to pick up at church.
- The fourth Wednesday of each month will be a time of prayer- both with some teaching and some praying.
- We will not meet on fifth Wednesdays of the month.

Genesis

This Sunday will be our final sermon in our series on the early chapters of Genesis. We will look at chapter 12 and the call of Abram. God calls Abram (later Abraham) to leave his homeland and follow God to a new home. In this call of Abram is a blessing- that God will bless Abram's family and through Abram's family, all the families of the earth will be blessed.

If the early chapters of Genesis constitute the first half of the Bible, then chapter 12 is the beginning of the second half of the Bible as the rest of the story plays out God's blessing on Abram. Join us on Sunday for this final Genesis sermon.
