I encourage you to visit www.kind30.org. As October gets closer, we will provide suggestions, opportunities and information.

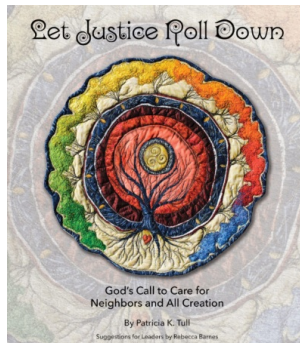
Let's spend October exploring and enacting kindness!

Missions Opportunities in September and October

Sunday, September 21 through October 30 -- Impact Church Food Pantry Diaper Drive



Patti Clark has presented us with an opportunity to help the Impact Church food pantry in East Point. They provide food they get from the Atlanta Food Bank to their community. However, they often hear of non-food needs such as diapers and other baby items, which cannot be purchased with SNAP funds and are even harder to come by for their clients. Needed items include diapers of all sizes. Target brand diapers are good and less expensive than some of the major brands. Smaller size packages are best for them so they do not have to separate and re-package the diapers before handing them out.

Other baby necessities requested are size 4T-5T pullups, diaper rash cream, baby wipes (and more baby wipes!). Costco has large boxes of baby wipes with nine packages of baby wipes inside. We will be collecting your items in the Narthex or they can be left in Room 202, The Gathering Spot. Links for Costco and Target are below.
