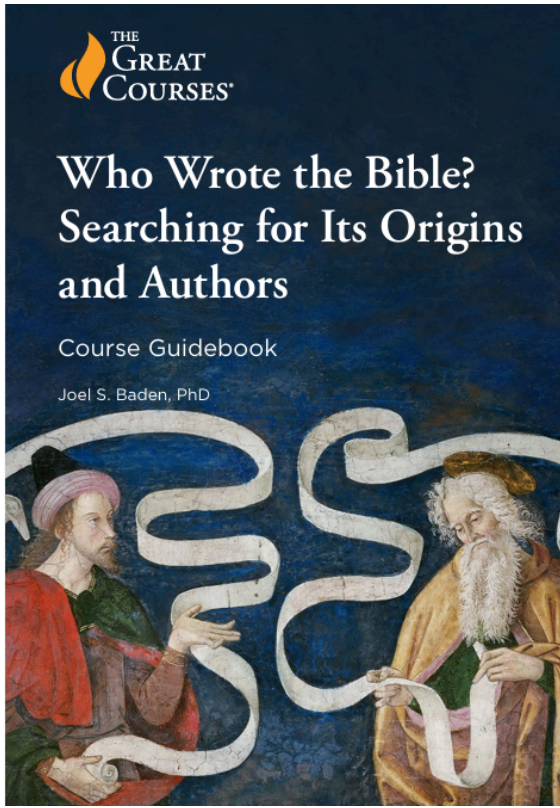
Madison holds a Bachelor of Music in Choral and General Music Education and a Master of Music in Choral Conducting from Georgia State University, where she currently serves as a conducting scholar and professor of Aural Skills. She has led multiple ensembles at GSU, including the American Prize-winning Treble Choir — a distinction that speaks volumes about her artistry and dedication.

Her church music experience is equally impressive. Most recently, Madison served as Conducting Scholar and Soprano Staff Singer at All Saints' Episcopal Church in Atlanta, where she directed a vibrant semi-professional chancel choir in Anglican chant and choral anthems. Her roots in church music go back many years, including work with youth and children's choirs at Lutheran Church of the Redeemer and First Presbyterian Church of Atlanta.

What truly sets Madison apart is her passion for people. In her own words, she believes that music ministry is about "creating a space where people feel safe to explore, express, and grow in their faith and artistry." That spirit is exactly what we hope to cultivate together here at Northside Drive.



Summer Study in Art & Soul | Sundays at 9:30 AM



This Sunday we continue our summer-long study of *Who Wrote the Bible?* This is a series produced by The Great Courses, a company whose excellent productions many of you are familiar with. Our study is written and presented by Dr. Joel S. Baden, professor of Hebrew Bible at Yale Divinity School. The series contains 24 episodes, and this summer we will study the first 12.

Each episode is accessible through Amplify Media. We will watch the video during the first half of our time together (the video will be shared via Zoom with those joining us remotely), and then we will talk about the video led by a discussion leader.

Joel S. Baden is Professor of Hebrew Bible at Yale University and the director of the Center for Continuing Education at Yale Divinity School. He holds a PhD in Hebrew Bible from Harvard University. He is the author of numerous books, including *The Composition of the Pentateuch* and *The Historical David*. He has published many scholarly articles and essays and has also written widely for a popular audience, in publications such as *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Atlantic*, *Slate*, *the Los Angeles Times*, and *the Daily Beast*.
