Opener

How would you describe the best day you've ever experienced?

Read

Philippians 1:20-26;

Main Points

1. Paul's view of death was not an end, but a transition to our final destination.
2. Some live their lives like this: To live is gain, and to die is loss. Others live like this: To live is gain, and to die is Christ.
3. *To live is Christ and to die is gain* means that Christ is our life.
4. As believers, we are invited to see all of life through the filter of Christ.
5. Death can only be a gain if Christ is your life.
 - a. Christ is honored in my life - to live is Christ. Christ is honored in my death - to die is gain.

Engage with God in a Group

- Have you ever met someone who's seemed to live with Christ as their life? Where they exemplified Paul's statement, *to live is Christ, to die is gain*?
- Will death be a loss for you, or will it be a gain?
- Is Christ your life? Do you see all of your life through the filter of Christ?
- In what areas of your life do you struggle to live with Christ as your life?
- How might the people closest to you describe your life?
- Who has God put in your life now that you think needs to come to the realization that Christ is life?
