Foundation Family Participation - 10% Tuition Credit

(1) Parishioners in good standing at Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Cathedral with baptized Orthodox Christian children enrolled at A. Fantis.

What does it mean to be a parishioner in good standing?

A parishioner in good standing is defined by the [Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America Uniform Parish Regulations](#) (Article 18, section 1-3). "At a minimum, a parishioner in good standing must: be eighteen years of age or over; be current in his or her stewardship and other financial obligations to the Parish (See church membership form), abide by all the regulations herein stated (in the UPR) and the Parish Bylaws; and cooperate in every way towards the welfare and well being of the Parish."

How does this work at Saints Constantine and Helen Cathedral and A. Fantis School?

Families are required to have their 2026 church membership paid and to have submitted their child's baptismal certificate in order to be eligible for tuition support. If you have not yet remitted your payment and would like us to charge your membership through FACTS, please see Ms. Stelene in the school office. (2) Parent volunteer commitment of at least 10 hours per family at our Annual Festival.
