Fairview Village Church of the Nazarene will elect Church Board Members on Sunday, January 19th and 26th, 2025. Members, ages 15 and above, will be given a ballot from which **four** (4) persons will be elected to serve a two-year term.

All of these candidates embrace the mission of the church, our stated objectives, our commitment to connect groups, local and global missions, and they support the ministry with tithes and offerings.

The Church Board is the legal board of the church and provides accountability to check the progress toward our stated purpose, objectives and plans, as well as act in an advisory capacity. This board will also approve candidates for auxiliary committees, as well as policies and procedures generated by these committees.
