

1. **What is *for the one*?** *For the one* is about serving The One, Jesus, by reaching the one who is lost. It's an emphasis – a focus on following the example of Christ, our Good Shepherd so closely that we'll leave the comfort of the 99 along with Him to find the one lost sheep. It's an opportunity – a decision to align our time, our talent, our testimony and our treasure. It's a commitment to give to the expansion of ministry avenues in service of the one who still needs to belong.
2. **What is the purpose of the *for the one* campaign?** God has blessed the ministry at The Village abundantly, evidenced by over 300 baptisms performed over the last few years, the effectiveness of our current ministries and the number of lives being transformed. Whenever God blesses someone, His intent is for the blessing to be shared, not simply kept. As such, we are now being called to increase our ministry avenues and create new ways to connect with people.
3. **What is the process of alignment we will be going through?** First, we will align our hearts with the truth that lost and broken people matter to The One, Jesus, until those people matter to us. This process is designed to strengthen our prayer lives, the power of our testimonies, and our ability to invite and give all for the sake of reaching “our one.”
4. **What is the time and talent part?** During the *for the one* emphasis, we will challenge our calendars and make sure they're not simply filled with activities, but actually creating positive movement. We will lean more intentionally into personal Bible reading, prayer, group life, regular church attendance, and exercising our gifts through service.
5. **What is the testimony part?** *For the one* will be a time to get clear on our personal relationships to The One, so we can explain and express our stories to others with conviction and confidence.
6. **What is the treasure part?** *For the one* is an opportunity to see what The One will do when we give beyond the basic command to tithe. Surrendering our financial habits in order to give back to God a tenth of what He provides to us is step one. *For the one* will increase our capacity to reach “our one” when we commit 2-3% above this amount. Even though we can't all give equally, we can all sacrifice equally.
7. **How will this culminate in me reaching my one?** If we participate in the spiritual emphasis of *for the one*, our hearts will be correctly positioned to enhance our current ministries and expand them into our proposed new areas.
8. **What is the plan for the treasure part?** The resources raised through *for the one* will be earmarked for four main projects: 1) making updates to the buildings and staffing the ministry at the Pottstown campus; 2) creating a children's experience open to the public at scheduled times during the week in the area outside of The Clubhouse; 3) constructing a permanent outdoor

platform on the Fairview campus front lawn to expand upon the success of our outdoor events; and 4) performing large maintenance and updates to the Fairview campus. These projects will only be completed if enough resources are raised. No money will be borrowed.

9. **Why can't we simply finance what we want to do?** We currently carry a debt that is sufficiently manageable to not require any ministry money to support. In addition, we have been able to accumulate considerable savings which provides a substantial headstart for our projects. Our conviction is to pay as we go and build as God provides.
10. **How will I know how much to give?** Pray about it. Seek the Lord and ask. Then, ask yourself, 'Is this my community? How much do I desire to grow it?' Upon that clarity, evaluate your capacity by looking at your finances and determining whether the standard additional 2-3% is feasible for you or if you can give a higher or lower percentage.
11. **How long will my commitment last?** *For the one* is a 3-year emphasis, but you can give a lump sum or make the number of payments that work for you.
12. **What can I give?** We have prepared a guide, *12 Ways to Give Sacrificially*, that can help.
13. **When will we make our commitments?** Commitment Sunday is March 22nd, 2026, but you can fill out and hand in your commitment card or make your pledge online anytime during *for the one*. Simply place it in an offering bucket.
14. **When will the giving begin?** First Fruits Sunday is April 26th, 2026.
