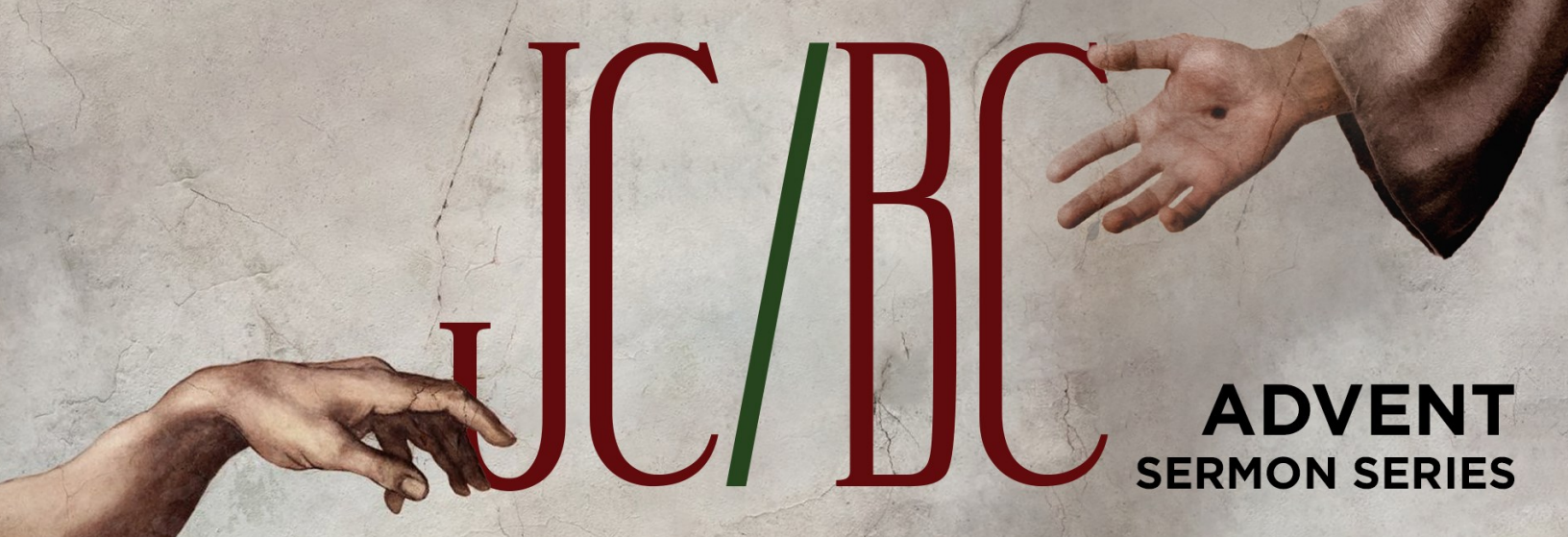




Jesus Shows Up in the “In Between”

- What stood out to you from last Sunday’s teaching?
- Everyone answer: On a scale of 1-10 (1 being not so good and 10 being incredibly well) rate yourself on how well you deal with change. Now, have someone else in the group who knows you rate you.
 - Why did you give yourself the score that you gave yourself?
 - If you gave someone else a score why did you give the score you gave?
 - If someone else rated you was their answer about how you deal with change surprising to you? Why or why not?
 - Change is a natural part of the human existence. As a group make a list of things that have drastically changed in your life from decade to decade starting with age 10.
 - How have you/would you help equip the next generation of children to be able to handle the change that they will experience in their lives
- What do you know about the story of Abraham? As a group brainstorm the highlights of his life.
- What do you know about how covenants work? Use your phone if needed.
- Read Genesis 15:1-21
 - What are some things that stick out to you in this passage?
 - Based on what you learned in the sermon and any research you can do on your phone right now... What is going on in this scripture?
 - What is the covenant that is being made?
 - By who is this covenant fulfilled?
 - Why do you think that God instituted a sacrificial system for sins?
 - What about the actions of God in this story surprises you?
- How does it comfort you to know that God would answer Abraham’s question and then take steps to give him reassurance?
- What struggles are you going through right now where you need God’s assurance?
