- What stood out to you from last Sunday's teaching?
- Everyone Answer: What is something you are afraid of?
 - What do you think started this fear and how long has it persisted in your life?
 - Have there been other fears that you have overcome? Why do you think you haven't overcome this fear?
 - How has this fear affected you and others?
- Read Psalm 23—Is there anything new that stood out to you as we read this passage?
 - According to this passage, what are the things that a shepherd leads his flock to or from?
- Read Numbers 13:1-24
 - What did the Lord know about Canaan that he wanted to lead his people there? *Think about how the shepherd leads in Psalm 23*
 - Why do you think God sent spies into the land of Canaan, since He already knew what was there?
 - Why do you think he sent a spy out from each tribe?
 - What does it tell you about the cluster of grapes that it had to be carried on a pole between two men? What might that cluster of grapes represent about the land they spied out?
- Read Numbers 13:25-33
 - Everything seemed so good! What happened?
 - How did the 10 spies fears exaggerate the dangers of trying to inhabit Canaan?
 - The decision was made to not inhabit Canaan. As a result, the only two people in the entire nation of Israel that got to see the promised land was Caleb and Joshua. What lesson might be taken from this story?
- Drive it home.
 - Think about your personal lives. Has God ever sent you in a direction you were unsure of? What was the result? Did you go?
 - What are some ways that God has lead you to provision in your life?
