 - What does it mean that "Christ lives in me"?
 - Read Matthew 16:24-26. How does this and the Galatians passage we just read compliment each other?
 - Two weeks ago, Pastor Harry taught us that trusting in God removes lack. In your own experiences, how have you needed trust to be crucified with Christ?
- Read Psalm 23—Is there anything new that stood out to you as we read this passage?
 - What do you desire for your life moving forward?
 - How do you reconcile the idea that you have wants for your life, but at the same time lack nothing as the Psalmist says in 23:1? Can you be both at the same time?
 - In his teaching last Sunday, Pastor Nick said that human desire is infinite. How have you experienced this truth?
 - Human desire is infinite because we crave the infinite. What part of Psalm 23 do you think addresses this thought.
- Our cup is not half full or half empty. Our cup overflows. In your own words what does it mean that our cup overflows? *Through faith our desires shift from worldly wants to spiritual wants... The fruit of the Spirit Gal 5*
