- What stood out to you from last Sunday's teaching?
- Everyone answer: Growing up, what were some of your families Easter Traditions?
 - Are there Easter traditions that you have kept from your childhood? Why?
 - Are there any Easter traditions that you have tried but didn't keep? Why?
 - The word "Easter" is derived from the pagan goddess, Eostre, who was associated with spring and fertility. The word, "Easter" was used by early Christians to mark the resurrection of Jesus Christ, which coincided with the spring festival of Eostre. What are your thoughts about this?
- What does the resurrection of Jesus mean to you personally?
 - How has your understanding of Easter changed over time? Think childhood until now.
 - Many people think that salvation is about "getting into heaven". In what ways is this true? In what ways is it more than that?
 - Pastor Dave often teaches that being a redemptive community has more to do with salvation than being a community of the redeemed. Unpack this thought. What do you think this means?
 - What is the mission and vision of Fairview Village Church? *To point people to Christ through Celebration, Connection, and Care.*
 - What does the mission and vision of Fairview Village Church have to do with *your* salvation?
- Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-15
 - What stands out to you as you read this passage?
 - How does this passage illustrate the alignment of our salvation with the mission of the church?
 - Everyone Share: Share the story of how you gave your life to Jesus.
 - What inspired you to take that step?
 - How often do you share that story?
 - What inspired you about someone else's story as the just shared it?
