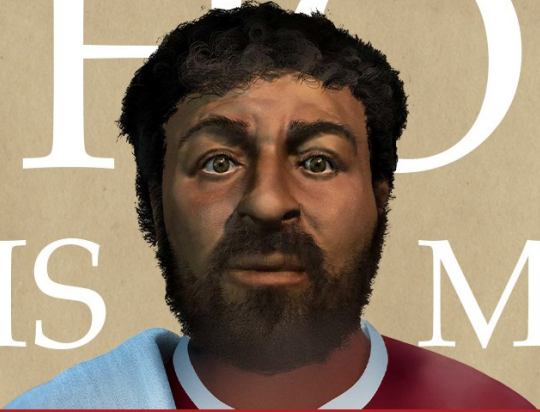


WHO IS THIS MAN?

 - Compare and contrast this miracle of Jesus with the one that we talked about last week. (Mark 4:35-41 for reference)
 - Jesus was confronted by the demoniac. The demons initiated the conversation by falling to his knees. This was not an act of worship but of terror. What might this tell you about the response of demons in the presence of Christ?
 - What is significant about the name that the Demon give to Jesus, "Son of the Most High God"?
 - The townspeople respond in the same way that the disciples had during the storm. They are in fear of the divine power that they had witnessed that was beyond any human capacity. Why do you think that fear was their first response?
 - How do you think they would try to answer the question, "Who is this Man?"
- What do you think that Pastor Dave meant when he said that darkness grows in the absence of light?
- In his teaching, Pastor Dave taught us that Jesus' actions for the demoniac are similar to how he responds to the darkness in us! 1. He came a great distance to make himself available and present. 2. Jesus identified how big the problems are. 3. The real Light shows up and darkness runs.
 - Describe your experience with each of these three actions of Jesus.
