Summer Worship Schedule, Offering Collection Update

Mark your calendars! Good Shepherd's Summer Worship Schedule will begin Sunday, May 26 (Memorial Day weekend), and run through Sunday, September 1 (Labor Day weekend). We will have one service each week, at 9:30 a.m., in the sanctuary.

With the change to the summer schedule, we will return to passing collection plates during the worship service, starting June 2. Because we have not used this procedure for a few years, we will hold a brief training session in the sanctuary after each service on May 19. This training session is appropriate both as a quick refresher for experienced ushers and as an opportunity for anyone who would like to understand what ushers do and maybe join the usher team.

We will need more ushers for the offering collection to work efficiently. Currently, we have two ushers at each service and would like to schedule four. Most ushers serve once every four or five weeks.
