AWord About Shepherds

Shepherds are people who simply 'walk along side' or accompany the Confirmand in their journev of faith formation. They are companions in faith during the Confirmation experience and beyond. Each Confirmand is expected to find his/her own Shepherd. This person MUST be an adult (over 21 years old) who you admire, know, and trust. We ask that they be a member of Centenary United Methodist Church and actively worshiping and growing in their own faith. Your Shepherd will meet with you once a month outside of class to work on your journal together, attend Shepherd nights, attend the retreats (see schedule for Shepherd nights and retreat dates), stand with you at your Confirmation, and commit to being your companion in faith over the next 5 years and beyond. Earnestly pray about who you might ask, as it is a very important decision, and then ask them soon! Cost for Shepherds is \$240.00 (books, meals and retreats).


What Is the Cost?
