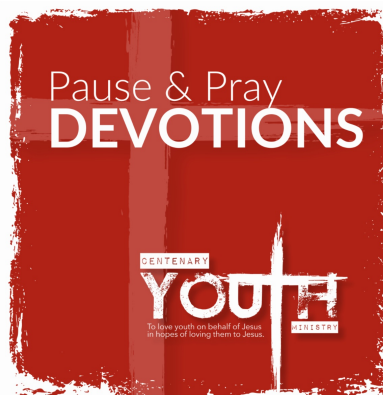

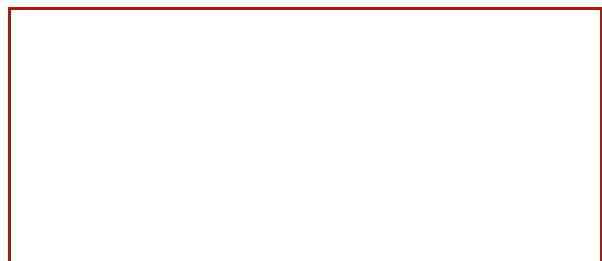
Thoughts on Today's Verse:

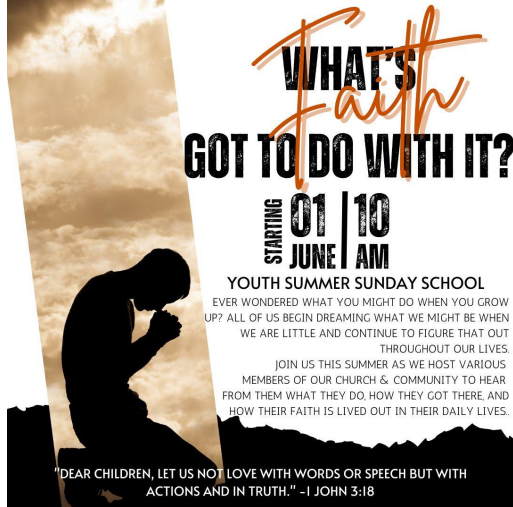
Let's praise and thank God our Father. He doesn't just forgive our sins; he removes them from us completely. Hallelujah!

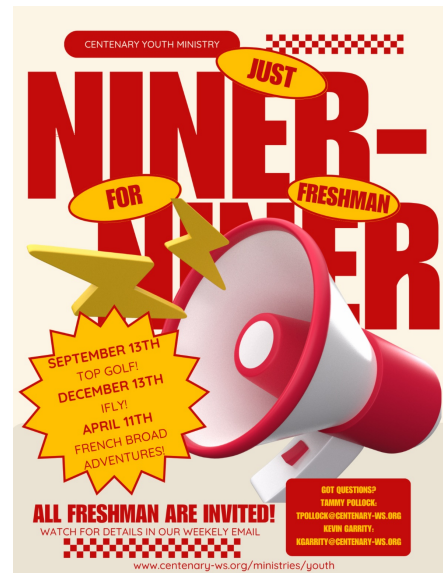


CALLING ALL YOUTH: BE A CMA CAMP COUNSELOR! July 14–17, 2025

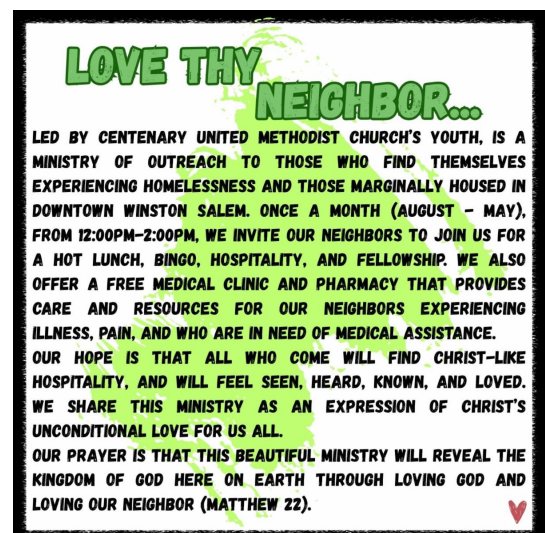

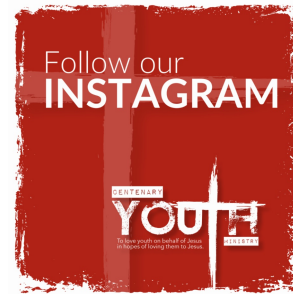
