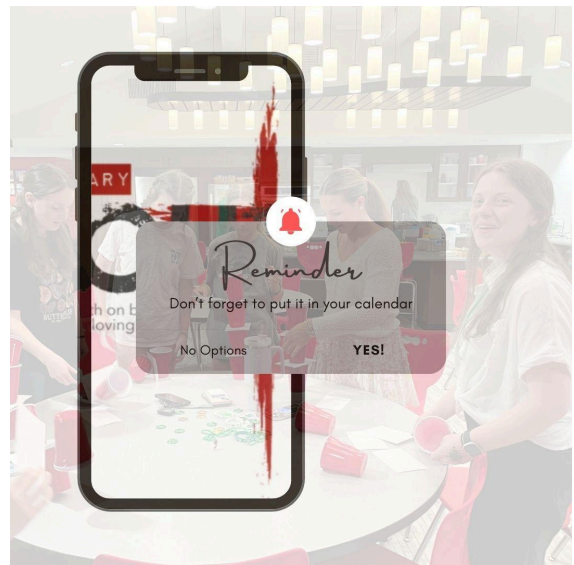

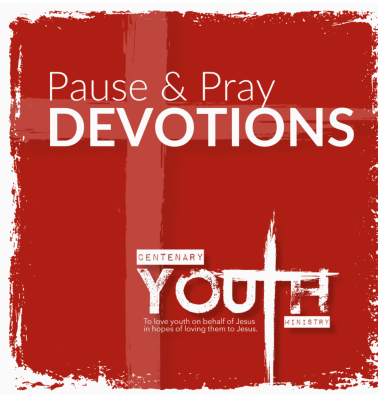

ARE YOU HEADING TO CAMP THIS SUMMER?

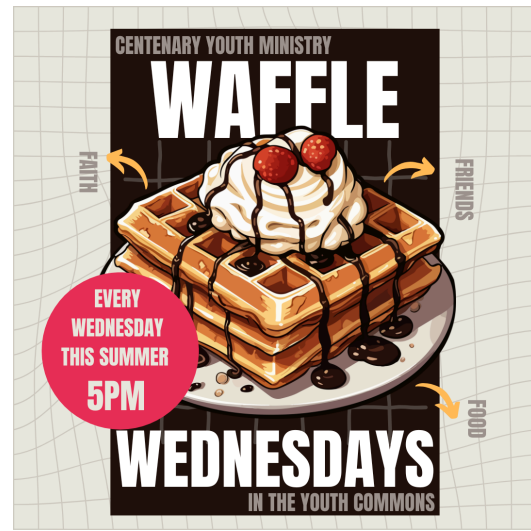

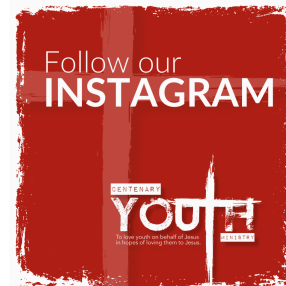
