Prayer is the primary work of God's people. It is a vital connection to God where we can hear from, listen to, and respond to the Lord. Here are some ways you can pray this week...


#### **Mission**Partners

## 641 When in Our Music God Is Glorified




Guitar chords do not correspond with keyboard harmony.
