# SCRIPTURE

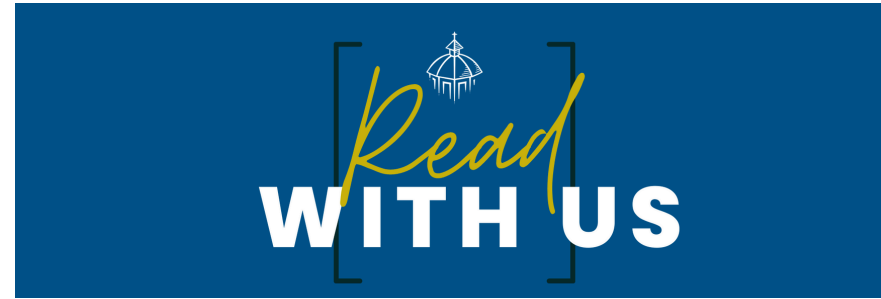

- Chris Scott, who has been ill for some time and is going through testing.



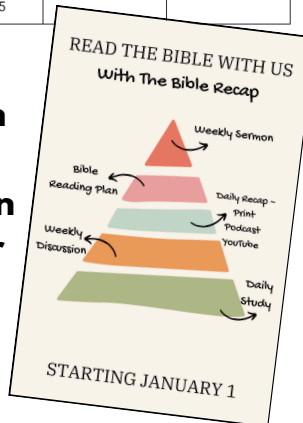
We have had one sermon series for the whole year, and we will continue reading through the whole Bible together using a specific reading plan. We hope you will read with us!
