SCRIPTURE

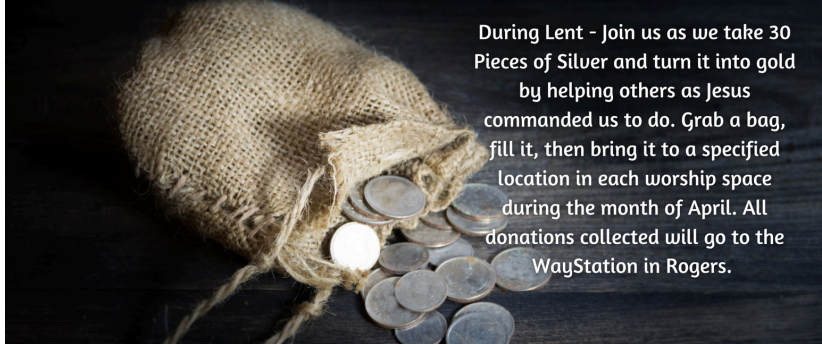
JOHN 19:28-29
