



It was on Good Friday that Jesus died, and during the Tenebrae service we will have witnessed the Light of Christ being extinguished. Somewhere between sundown Saturday and sunrise Easter Sunday, Jesus arose from the dead. Our Vigil will begin at sundown, with everyone gathering outside of the Chapel, while we light a new fire. From it, the Paschal Candle is lit and the light of Christ will return to the Chapel, with a celebration ensuing.
