- Jenny McDaniel, for the Lord to work powerfully to heal her brain bleed.



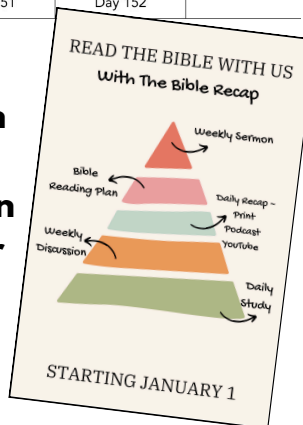
We are excited to share that in 2024 we will have one sermon series for the whole year, and we will be reading through the whole Bible together using a specific reading plan. MAY
