ZECHARIAH 2:1-5

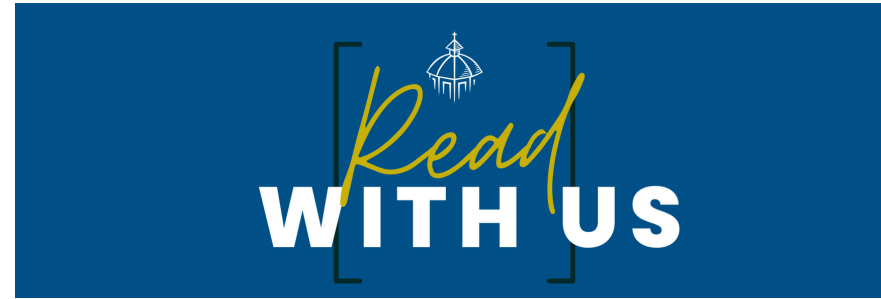
Future Prosperity of Jerusalem

We have had one sermon series for the whole year, and we will continue reading through the whole Bible together using a specific reading plan. We hope you will read with us!

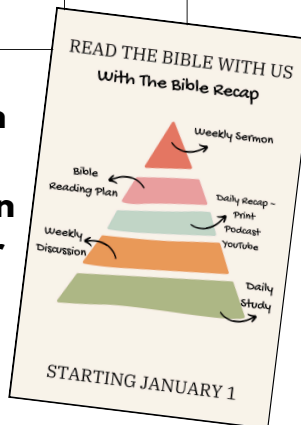
