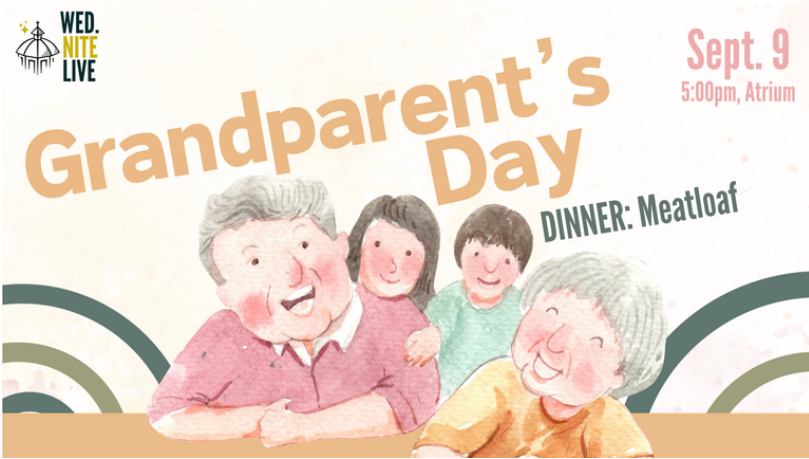
PRAYER REQUESTS
