# 2ND SUNDAY OF LENT GOSPEL MEDITATION

As a college student, my prized possession was an aftermarket car stereo. It was my pride and joy: glorious audio, eye-catching display screen, and multi-disc CD changer. It drained my hard-earned dollars, but it was totally worth it. It drenched me in music everywhere I drove. On Ash Wednesday of my senior year of college, Father Tom, the Jesuit priest at my university said, "Pray for God to tell you what he wants you to sacrifice for Lent." I did. In my heart, the answer came: "Give up listening to your car stereo for forty days." I winced. Not possible, I thought. Can't do it. I made other plans. The next morning, I was stunned to find that my car had been broken into, my fancy stereo ripped out and stolen.

God's command to sacrifice what we love is no joke. This week in Genesis 22, God says: "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love — Isaac — and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." Believe me, I know. We like to be in control. It chaffs us that God sets the terms of what we must sacrifice and how. But this is no impersonal, tyrannical process. Remember that God uses their names, Abraham and Isaac. God knows each one of us and the precious gifts He commands us to offer. Finally, our sacrifices are for our own good. Do we trust this enough to do what Father Tom asked me to do?

Lenten challenge: This week, I dare you to ask God: "What do you want me to give up?" He may ask for that which you love most. It will be something precious to you: time, money, a relationship, a dream, an opportunity. What matters is we trust Him and act sacrificially in line with His command. Whatever we sacrifice will of course come back to us as surely as the Risen Jesus — but that doesn't make it easy.


### Reflection questions for Sunday, March 3rd

### TESTIMONIAL BY PARISHIONER TRICIA HALVERSON

Matthew 25:37-40

Visiting the Dominican Republic with a few St. Charles parishioners was a life-changing experience for me. Poverty can be a concept, and what we see in pictures or on television is different than seeing it firsthand. Locking eyes and exchanging smiles with a young woman bathing her child in a nearby stream; seeing a man my age bathing in an aqueduct in the middle of the day, these were just a couple of humbling moments for me. Touring villages with makeshift homes with dirt floors and pieced together materials, which cannot even withstand a storm, was eye-opening. Visiting "nutrition centers" where the primary goal was to give young children from the ages of 2-5 two meals a day was surprising. Starvation was seen on every corner.

However, there is great hope! We met a young man and woman who are taking the brave step to leave their village during the day and study at the university in Azua with the desire to better themselves and their local community. It was a true blessing to participate in a mass where eight inmates from a high security prison received their First Communion. Three children were baptized at our sister parish of La Sagrada Familia. Houses made of concrete are being built by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. The Holy Spirit is alive and active! While I wanted to go to the Dominican Republic (DR) to evangelize, I was being evangelized by the generous love and humble spirit of the poor.

I am excited to continue St. Charles' mission of being one body in Christ and present opportunities for parishioners to get involved in continuing the work being done in the DR. Please think about giving to this incredible cause!

It is easy to say the words, but it is entirely different to experience them: The gift of sitting before Jesus in Holy Adoration has changed my life.

What a gift we have at St. Charles to spend time with the Lord on our own schedule. To go and be with Him who soothes our every trouble and rejoices at our every happiness. When my children are struggling, when life seems too much, when friends are suffering, when I feel helpless among tragedies, the best help I can offer is to lift them up in prayer. I can bring all these sufferings and joys to the foot of our Savior, knowing He is the only one who can pour out the graces needed for each situation. While sitting in adoration, the Lord brings a truly peaceful, calming presence. And so I invite you - come as you are, come before Him with all your brokenness and pain, bring your joys and longings. Show him your love; He will multiply your blessings.






