




5TH SUNDAY OF LENT GOSPEL MEDITATION

A middle-aged woman sat on the couch in my parish office and recounted to me a shocking list of terrible calamities in her life: addictions, terminal illnesses, financial loss, broken relationships, and so on. She smiled as she did so. "Please forgive me," I asked, "but you seem to be smiling as you share this." She said, "Father John, I am totally overwhelmed. But I'm smiling because I just can't wait to see what good things God does with this mess." She expected God would manifest His glory when she most needed it.

This week in the Gospel, God speaks from heaven for the third and final time in Jesus' earthly ministry. It's at a tough moment. Gentiles seek Jesus, who announces his terrible suffering, and then boldly prays, "Father, glorify your name!" John then writes: Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." Was the task of drawing the whole non-Jewish world to himself overwhelming? Or was it the terrible specter of crucifixion? Whatever it was, the crushing weight triggers his turning to the Father with an unshakeable expectation of divine glory to burst through. And indeed, it did on Easter Sunday. In our burdens, our greatest strength is to turn to God and boldly ask Him for His glory.

Lenten challenge: This week, I invite you to list out everything which is a burden to you. Write it down. Then add these words: "Father, glorify Your name in all these things!" Put that paper in your pocket or purse when you come to Holy Week liturgies next week. You might smile at the most unlikely times.

JOURNEY FROM LENT TO EASTER



PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION MARCH 24TH

At Palm Sunday Mass, we start by singing, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" echoing the joyful shouts that welcomed Christ into Jerusalem. Later in the Mass, we recall Christ's suffering and death. No other Sunday in the liturgical year takes us from such an emotional high to the depths of pain and grief. It is the start of Holy Week.

At the 11:00 am Mass, all parishioners are invited to gather at the west doors by the corridor to the new church. Father Ken will be wearing red. We will hear the introductory prayers, have our palms blessed, and hear the Processional Gospel. We will process through the corridor to the church. At all other Masses, this action takes place in the back of the church, and there is a simple procession. We will wave our palms as the people of Jerusalem did and sing "All Glory, Laud and Honor."

As we enter church, we see that the cross is covered. It will remain covered until Good Friday. The scripture readings draw us into the mystery of Christ's suffering. We pray the beautiful Psalm 22: "My God, My God, Why Have You Abandoned Me?" During the Gospel, we take part in proclaiming the Passion of our Lord. We hear the crowd yell "We want Barabbas!" and "Crucify him!", and we reverently kneel as we hear that Jesus breathed his last. At Offertory, we sing "Were You There?" At the end of Mass, we depart in solemn silence.

As we relive this mystery of Christ's suffering and death, there are many feelings to unpack. The Son of God rode into Jerusalem in triumph and is now preparing to die. How will you and your family keep vigil this week? How can you talk with your children about sacrifice, giving, and forgiving? As we enter into this holiest of weeks, may our participation in each liturgy draw us deeper into union with Christ and with one another.



The food pantry will be closed when Arrowhead Schools close for inclement weather. It will open the following week, weather permitting.


